WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the process for booking Carrie as the photographer for our wedding?

A: To formally book Carrie for your wedding day, a 50 percent deposit of the total package is required to hold the date. It is due immediately along with the signed contract. Please contact Carrie to receive a contract, which can be mailed or faxed back to her at the information provided. Due to high demand and a long term booking schedule, all deposits are non-refundable.

Q: Are there any time limits for Carrie to photograph my wedding day?

A: Due to popular demand Carrie now offers packages based on the duration of each shoot. This gives couples more of a choice. Although she feels that the Diamond package, which is her unlimited time package, is one of the best features of her service. She knows each day is unique and unfolds in it's own way without the added pressure of time constraints.

Q: How much experience does Carrie have?

A: Carrie has 12 years of photographic experience. She is a fashion/ portrait photographer, whose work has been published in numerous magazines. Her training and extensive commercial experience is what sets her apart from all shooters. See the bio section on this website for further details.

Q: Will Carrie travel for weddings?

A: Yes, Carrie is happy to travel for weddings. Due to your event's schedule or destination, if Carrie and her crew are required to travel a day early or leave the day after, a travel fee is TBD. In addition all other travel expenses (airfare, hotel, meals, car, etc...) will be determined and that rate billed directly to the client. Billing for all travel expenses will be due before the day of the event.

Q: When will I receive the proofs of my wedding?

A: You will receive online proofs within 2 weeks of your wedding. The proof book takes 3 to 4 weeks to turn around. You will receive the high-resolution DVD of your wedding images 6 months from your wedding date.

Q: Will I be able to view my photographs online?

A: Yes, along with your family and friends, you will be able to view your images and order prints online for one year. There is a link on Carrie's site to direct you to your event.

Q: Does Carrie photograph engagement photos and rehearsal dinners?

A: Yes, she does. See A La Carte section under Info header on her site for all the details.

Q: Will Carrie be my photographer?

A: Yes, Carrie personally photographs every wedding. She does work with an assistant at all times. She recommends a second shooter if there are 200+ guests.

Q: Where is Carrie based?

A: Carrie splits her time between New York City and LightWave Studio in Newport, RI. But that doesn't limit the area she covers to shoot. She travels all over the globe for destination weddings.
